CURRENTLY, THIS DOES NOT ALLOW ADEQUATE WATER PRESSURE TO SUPPLY WATER TO THE UPPER FLOORS OF THE SCHOOL AND THERE ARE ALSO PROBLEMS PROVIDING ADEQUATE WATER TO THE RECENTLY CONSTRUCTED COURT HOUSE IN MT. OLIVET. THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ELEVATED TANK WOULD ALLOW ADEQUATE TURNOVER OF WATER TO SERVICE THESE AREAS AS WELL AS THE RESIDENTS OF THE SYSTEM. IN ADDITION, APPROXIMATELY 1200' OF 1-1/2" AND 2" LINES WILL BE REPLACED WITH 3" AND 4" LINES. THESE ARE LOCATED IN THE CENTER OF MT. OLIVET NEAR THE COURT HOUSE AND CITY HALL.
